
**INTERVENOR-DEFENDANT'S

BUREAU STATUS REPORT**

As directed by the Court, Intervenor-Defendant Washington State Farm Bureau ("WSFB") hereby provides this status report to describe the steps it has taken to comply with the Court's Order dated January 22, 2004.

Washington State Farm Bureau, an Intervenor-Defendant in Washington Toxics Coalition v. EPA, hereby confirms that, pursuant to the directive of the January 22, 2004 Court Order, WSFB has distributed written notification to its members by publishing a story in its monthly newsletter with information of the Court Orders dated July 2, 2002; July 16, 2003; August 8, 2003, and January 22, 2004. WSFB complied with the Judge's Court Order by distributing notification via the

1 newsletter instead of by direct mail because the cost for direct mailing would have been more than
2 \$34,000.00.
