

**APPLICATION FOR EXAMINATION:
UNDERGROUND COAL MINE INSPECTOR**

MINIMUM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates for Underground Mine Inspector must be:

- A citizen of West Virginia, in good health, not less than twenty-four years of age, of good character and reputation and of temperate habits;
- A person who has had practical experience with dangerous gases found in coal mines;
- A person who has good theoretical and practical knowledge of mines, mining methods, mine ventilation, sound safety practices, and applicable mining laws and rules.
- Candidates must possess five years of practical experience in coal mines, at least two years of which have been in mines in this state; **PROVIDED**, that graduation and a 4-year degree from an accredited college of mining engineering may be considered the equivalent of two years of practical experience.

If you meet these minimum requirements, **you must attach official documentation from your employer(s) detailing your years of underground coal mining experience, and the occupation(s) or classification(s) at which you were employed**, beginning with your current employer and position, or your most recent employer and position if you are not currently employed in the underground coal mining industry.
