NRC Information Quality Guidelines

Do the NRC's Information Quality Guidelines achieve the goals set out by the OMB's

Does the NRC clearly describe how quality is addressed in all information products

Does the NRC clearly describe what information products are subject to these guidelines and the administrative mechanism for correction?

Procedures for the Public to Seek Correction of Information Under Section

Is the NRC process described in sufficient detail to allow the public to submit a request for correction to an information product?

Does the NRC process provide adequate avenues for submitting a request?

Do the NRC procedures clearly communicate that an appeal can be requested if the request for seeking correction has been denied?
