The major impetus for this appears to come from the House, where the companion bill is HR 5002. That bill was reported out of the Merchant Marine Committee on May 17, 1982. Commerce discovered this provision several weeks ago and claims that they have contacted numerous people on the Hill to alert them that the Administration opposes this exclusion. It would appear that the message has not gotten through. Bob Carlstrom suggests that Commerce send a letter to the HILL. Also attached is the signing statement for the Marine Mammals Bill.
